



Gauley River







The Gauley River National Recreation Area includes 25 miles of the Gauley River. This swift, winding river and its narrow gorge are protected by the National Park Service.

This renowned river is consistently ranked among the top rivers in the world by expert paddlers, based on its technical rapids, scenic quality and inaccessibility. The fall Lower Gauley is considered a moderate adventure and combines exhilarating rapids with magnificent scenery from start to finish.

The Lower Gauley is characterized by big whitewater, invigorating rapids and breathtaking scenery. This adventure is well suited for enthusiastic first time rafters and is often the next step after rafting the Lower New River.




